TIMINGS OF THE DAY

Those who are travelling with us by coach, please arrive at the Academy by 9am. Take a Bow require the entire team to be at the stage door by 12:30pm. For those who are meeting us there, you must be on time to avoid delays. All dancers should wear their training vest (non-glitter print) and an SA cover up to arrive at the theatre. Those that don't have an SA cover up please wear something plain black.

Doors to the theatre open at 5:30pm and the show starts at 6:30pm. The show will end at around 8:45pm. Announcements will be made where children should be collected.

WHAT TO BRING

Below is a checklist of everything you will need to pack for your dancer. The colour of the group refers to the colour of your leotard.

Blue & purple group:

- Leotard
- Tan/skin colour lyrical shoes
- Tan/skin colour dance tights
- Hair bobble to match hair colour
- Hairbrush
- Hairspray/gel
- Makeup
- Black performance team training vest (glitter print)
- Black leggings
- Black shoes

Pink group:

- Leotard
- Denim shorts
- Black fur gilet
- Tan/skin colour lyrical shoes
- White trainers
- Tan/skin colour dance tights
- Hair bobble to match hair colour
- Hair brush
- Hairspray/gel
- Makeup
- Black performance team training vest (glitter print)
- Black leggings
- Black shoes
- Small box for quick changes

Please pack plenty of food and drink to last the whole day. Please do not pack food that contains nuts.

HAIR & MAKEUP

The hairstyle for the show will be a low ponytail with a middle parting. Please make sure all loose/baby hairs are slicked back and hair gel or spray has been used for a clean, slick look. We would also advise that you use more than one hair bobble to ensure that the ponytail stays in place during the performance.

Makeup is a gold/bronze smoky eye and red lipstick. We would also advise using bronzer for fairer skin tones as stage lights tend to wash out facial features.

Dancers do not need to have hair and makeup done before entering the theatre in the morning. Chaperones will be available to help younger dancers with hair and makeup backstage.
